
## **Purpose**


# **Editing the Protocol**

#### 1. Navigate to Settings




#### 2. Select Protocol Editor



### Write the Protocol

Add headers, bullet points, and bold font. There is no one-size-fits all formula for a protocol! The goal of a 'best practices' protocol should be: enable someone unfamiliar with the project to carry out any of the Search, Screening, Tagging, Extraction, or interpretive tasks in your project in the same way that you, as project lead, would do.

### **Share the Protocol**

The protocol will appear at the nest home! Ensure that all reviewers on your team know where to find the Protocol. Optionally, you can download the protocol as a Word document in one-click.

The Protocol generally does not usually include specific reviewing instructions; it contains generalized nest methods. Be sure to communicate individual instructions and deadlines outside of the Protocol's contents.
