Formatting the Title Page

Things to keep in mind

- Some titles have a character limit of 20 words.
- Include authors and affiliations as required by the journal.

How should affiliations be denoted? Are the highest academic degrees needed? Middle initials?

- Other commonly required title page information includes the following:
 - 1. Keywords according to the MeSH database, if required
 - 2. The running title/running head will be a few words that summarize your paper
 - 3. Highlights
 - 4. Word count, which generally excludes the title page, the abstract, and anything after the conclusion.
 - 5. Statements (acknowledgments, funding sources, disclosures, etc.)
